Submission Type:

* Abstract submission for presentation only without publication. (<u>Template Download</u>)

* Full paper submission for both presentation and

publication. (MS Word Template) (LaTeX Template)
Paper Length: Each full paper should be no less than 4
full pages in two columns, including all figures, tables,
and references. When it exceeds 5 pages, extra page will
be charged.

Papers submitted to the conference should report original, previously unpublished research results, experiments or theories and must not be under consideration for publication elsewhere.
